
Taking a Quiz in Moodle

Your quiz type will vary according to your instructor's quiz settings. When taking a quiz in Moodle, the question types include, but are not limited to multiple choice, short answer, numeric questions, and essays.

This tutorial will demonstrate the steps to follow when taking a quiz in Moodle.




Step 2

You will now see the quiz settings set by your instructor.

To start taking the quiz, select:

Attempt quiz




The quiz settings in this example include the number of attempts allowed, open date, time limits, and grading method.


A popup box will appear. Read the quiz instructions if any, and select:

Start Attempt

to open the quiz.




The quiz questions are now displayed, and if there's a time limit restriction, the timer at the top left of your screen will start counting down. Also, notice the two blue boxes above the timer representing the quiz questions. You can select these boxes if you want to revisit or navigate the questions.



Read the quiz instructions and select or type your answer for each question according to the type of quiz you are taking.

When finished with quiz questions, select:

Finish Attempt



Step 5


To submit your quiz, select:

Submit all and finish

Or select:


Return to attempt

to review or change the quiz questions.



A popup box will appear to confirm your quiz submission, to continue, select:

Submit all and finish




Step 7

According to the quiz settings, you may see test data, including your grade.

You may finish the review, by selecting:

Finish review




Finally, you will see a summary of your previous attempts, and your final grade for the quiz. If more attempts remain, you can select:

Reattempt the quiz

Or,

Back to course

To exit.



Note: In this example the two allowed attempts were performed.
